

Following are the approximate letter grade cut-offs from exam 3:

Overall average for Exam 3: 65.3

A 90 - 100

B 80 - 89

C 60 - 79

D 45 - 59

F 0 - 44

Also, this curve should not be used as an absolute determination of what letter grade you have in the course. It is provided for your own information and as an indication of how your score compares to others. Also consider where in the range your score falls. For example, a score of 80 could be regarded as a C or a B (it is very close to a C). Your **TOTAL NUMBER OF POINTS** earned during the semester determines your final letter grade in the course.

During dead week, your instructor will provide you with a sticker that will include the following information: your three exam scores, your ending online HW score (with the four lowest dropped) out of 50 possible points, and your current quiz score (with the four lowest so far dropped) out of a possible 100 points. There are several more quizzes and paper and pencil HW's that will be collected during class, but the sticker will be fairly accurate. You will know approximately what letter grade you have in the course going into the final exam.

The final exam is worth 200 out of 650 points (or about 30% of your final letter grade). Be sure to keep up with class and on the paper and pencil homework as the final exam has at least 7-8 questions from chapter 5 (out of 30 questions).
